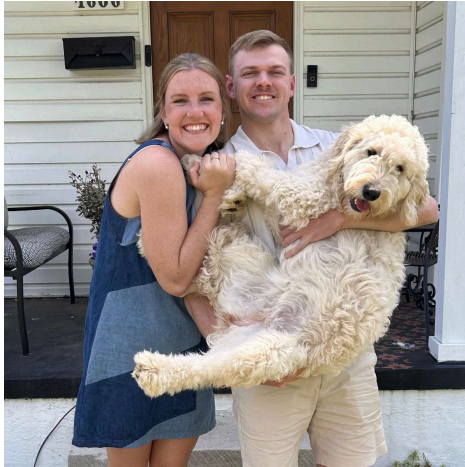
The Marriage Intensive was great. The food...maybe greater!!
