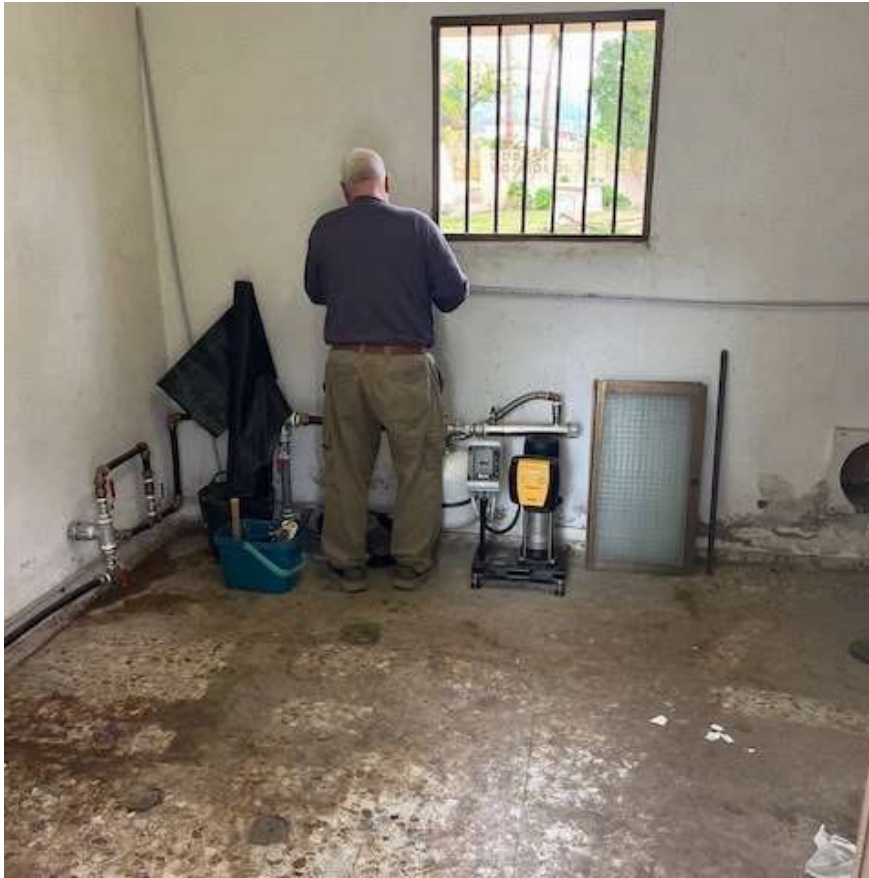


It has been too long...and I have a lot to report
