	CHURCH PLANTING (ACTS 3:1-13)	LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT (EPHESIANS 4:11-16)
MONDAY	PLANTER That God would raise up the first man to lead our church plant.  Praise God for his sovereignty and goodness.	LEADERS  That God would raise up the right leader for every ministry, class, and group within the church.  Ask God if he would have you step into a leadership role.
TUESDAY	TIME/PLACE That God would direct us to plant in the right time and right place.  Ask God to make clear to us when & where—and to smooth the way once we know.	LEADERSHIP PIPELINE  That God would raise up ready successors for every ministry, class, and group within the church.  Ask God if he would have you prepare to step into a leadership role. If you're a leader, ask God to show you who he'd have succeed you.
WEDNESDAY	TEAM  That God would gather the planting team from among our congregation.  Ask God if he is leading you (& your family) to be part of the planning team.	VOLUNTEERS  That God would raise up gifted, passionate volunteers to serve in every needed role in the church.  Ask God if he would have you step into a ministry role. If you're a leader, ask God if he'd have you reach out to someone to serve in the ministry/group you lead.
THURSDAY	FINANCES  That God would provide the finances to reduce our debt & fund the plant.  Ask God if he would have you increase your regular giving or make a one-time over-and-above gift.	EVERY-MEMBER MOBILIZATION  That everyone who calls Cityview home would be actively serving in ministries where they're gifted and passionate.  If you're not serving, ask God to show you where you should be.
FRIDAY	VISION  That God would unite the congregation around the vision.  Ask God to help you work through any questions internally or follow a godly process	That you (and the entire congregation) would see yourself as a minister of the gospel responsible for the ministry of the church.  Do you see yourself as responsible for ministry or do

questions internally or follow a godly process

to work through them with church leadership.

	INNOVATIVE OUTREACH (ACTS 1:8)	GOSPEL HEALTH (ACTS 2:42-47)
MONDAY	Innovation  That the Spirit would inspire creative new initiatives that will allow us to reach new people in new ways.  What ideas has the Spirit laid on your heart for innovative outreach? Is the Spirit leading you to be part of the innovation team?	Gospel That both our message and ministry practices would remain resolutely grace-based and gospel-centered.  Take some time to reflect on the gospel and what it means for your life today.
TUESDAY	Implementation  That men and women filled with the Spirit would step forward to see those new ideas become reality (cf. Acts 6:1-7).  Is the Spirit leading you to be a part of the implementation team?	Discipleship  That we would remain resolutely committed to relational disciple-making as individuals and as a church.  Ask God to show you how you can be involved in making disciples even today.
WEDNESDAY	Oikos  That everyone who calls Cityview home would proclaim the gospel boldly and winsomely among their oikos.  Ask God to add new names to your oikos list—and to give you the words and boldness to reach them this week.	Community That the Spirit would keep us unified through the bond of peace (Ephesians 4:1-3).  Ask God to reveal any disunity in your heart. What is the Spirit prompting you to do about it?
THURSDAY	Initiatives  That the corporate evangelistic initiatives we have in place now (e.g., CAP, IFI, Sunday service invites) would lead to many conversions.  How might God be leading you to join our corporate evangelistic initiatives?	Leadership That the elders of the church would strive to be a humble, servant-hearted plurality.  Commit to praying for your leaders regularly (Hebrews 13:7).
FRIDAY	Revival  That God would bring revival in our time in this place.  Ask God to give you a heart for intercessory prayer and confession—the precursors to all true revival.	Mission/Values  That God would keep us on mission in line with our core values: God's Word, Spiritual Life, Gospel-Centered Ministry, Relational Disciple-Making, Transformative Community, Authentic Worship, and a Missional Mindset.
