# **Family Ministry Philosophy**

We believe the Bible calls parents to be the primary disciple-makers of their children. But being the primary doesn't mean only. The whole church should be involved in the discipleship of children and teenagers. This whole-church discipleship can happen formally and informally.

Formally, our Family Ministries consist of ministries designed for children, preteens, teens, and parents. These formal ministries seek to equip everyone according to their physical, emotional, social, and spiritual maturity. When leading these ministries, we follow Cityview's mission, vision, and values. We also desire to see all of our children, especially preteens and up, in one-on-one or one-on-few discipleship relationships with another believer in the church.

Informally, when you live out biblical community with other believers, you show children how essential the 'one another' passages are in Scripture and how the church is not just something we go to but a community of God's redeemed people who share their lives. When children walk into the church on Sunday, they are a part of our family, and everyone from the person greeting them when they walk into the building, their Explore Hour teacher, the preachers proclaiming God's Word, the deacon serving communion, to the adult they see in the hallway all have an opportunity to encourage and speak into the lives of our children with gospel truth.

If we do all of this well, we believe we are being faithful in living out the great commission from Jesus in the two most significant institutions God has given us – the church and home.

# Where

Both Explore Hour and Youth Group meet downstairs in the Family Ministries Room CityStu exists to equip students in 6-12 grade to magnify Christ and serve others. We want to see our students grow in their faith so that they are able to face the world as committed disciples of Jesus Christ. We do this by sticking to our core values of God's Word, spiritual life, authentic worship, missional mindset, transformative community, gospelcentered ministry, and relational disciplemaking.

# **Explore Hour**

We meet on Sunday mornings to connect with friends and learn important truth from God's Word.

# Youth Group

We meet on Sunday evenings to connect with friends, play games, hear from God's Word, and spend time in community groups.

# **Retreats**

Students get away from normal life to spend time with friends, enjoy camp, and connect with God. We have retreats in fall and winter.

# **Explore Hour**

Middle School (6-8) will meet on Sunday mornings to work through the Rooted Bible Study material. High School (9-12) will spend most weeks in the Cityview Explore Hour elective classes with agespecific classes scheduled throughout the year.

# Discipleship Framework:

We believe the Bible calls parents to be the primary disciple-makers of their children (Deut 6:6-9; Ps 78:4-8; Eph 6:4; 2 Tim 1:5, 3:15). We also realize that family dynamics, culture, age, life change, etc. can all have an effect on the way discipleship happens in the home. Therefore, we have provided what we feel is a helpful framework that can be used in all contexts as parents seek to disciple their children. There is a lot of flexibility within this framework that can help you tailor it to the needs and spiritual development of you and your children. It is our hope that if you focus on these 4 Cs (Consider, Create, Capture, and Celebrate) then you will be a much more effective disiple-maker of your children as you seek to help your children know, love, and serve Jesus.

# THE 4 Cs OF FAMILY DISCIPLESHIP



Consider your own life and how you are growing as a disciple of Jesus Christ. If we are calling our children to consider Jesus and give up everything to follow him, then they must see us doing the same.

Create discipleship opportunities right into the everyday rhythm of life where your family can be grounded in the gospel. Families must worship together by reading Scripture, singing, and praying.

Target Age Range: 0-2 years old

Parents commit to raise their child in a gospelcentered home, and the church commits to partnering with parents in this important work.

#### Church Celebration

Parents and child(ren) will come up front for a special time in the service. There will be a short challenge for parents followed by a parental and church commitment to disciple the child(ren).

When children repent of their sins and trust in Jesus, we will celebrate that in the ordinances instituted by Christ, first with a baptism service and then with regular participation in the Lord's Supper.

Mark this occasion with a special time or meal with family and friends to celebrate that your child has been born again to a new life in Jesus Christ.

**Good News Class |** A one-night gospel class called *The Good News* will be offered for parents and their preschool through 3rd-grade students every year. The gospel will be proclaimed to the children along with an explanation of baptism and communion.

# Welcomed

Target Age Range: 9-11 years old

The church presents preteens with a Bible and welcomes them into regular participation in the worship service.

### **Church Celebration**

Children graduate from Kids' City after third grade. We have them come to the front of the auditorium on Promotion Sunday to welcome them into full participation in the worship service as they enter our preteen ministry, CityLink. They are encouraged and challenged while also receiving from the church a Bible, a worship journal, and a resource on helping them study the Bible on their own.

# **Family Celebration**

As a family, celebrate with a meal after church and discuss the importance of Scripture, corporate worship, and hearing God's Word preached.

# **Parent & Student Equipping**

The What is the Worship Service? class is offered on Promotion Sunday to all 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade CityLink students and parents. We discuss the different components of the worship service, how the students can get the most out of the service, and serving at Cityview.

#### Church Celebration

Relational disciple-making is one of our values at Cityview. So, we often talk from the front about how important it is for our children and teenagers to be in these relationships, and celebrate when our church lives out this value.

# Family Celebration

Make it a priority for the child or teen to meet with their disciple-maker regularly. Don't just celebrate the relationship, but also pray for spiritual transformation.

Many parent workshops are designed with relational disciple-making in the home in mind. Workshops will also equip disciple-makers so that the church and home work together in the discipleship of children.
