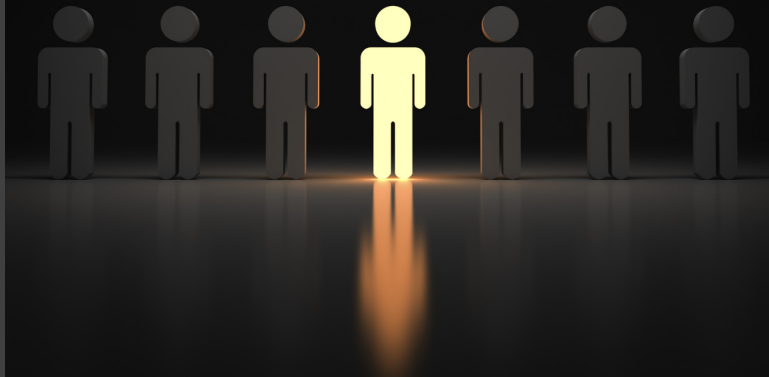

Explaining Christian Denominations to Children

As our children grow up there will inevitably be some conversation around what our church believes and the other churches in your neighborhood or where other family and friends go. Explaining the difference between different Christian denominations is a lot more difficult than explaining the difference between Christianity and other world religions.

Trevin Wax in his article on TGC gives us some simple ways to explain the difference between Christian denominations. you can use this as a quick guide when your kids

have questions or even just walk through each of them over time and help train up your children. You should probably see in the descriptions that the Christian churches would profess belief in the essential doctrines (i.e. the Trinity, the incarnation, Jesus' life, death, and resurrection), but will differ on secondary (i.e. baptism, the Lord's Supper) and tertiary matters (i.e. music style, meeting space).


