

Room for Jesus

Entering the sanctuary of my home church for a Christmas concert this last Saturday, I (Faith) felt more weary and needy in heart and body than my head was ready to admit. As we sang the familiar words from the carol "Joy to the World", "Let every heart prepare Him room, and Heav'n and nature sing", Greg squeezed my

hand acknowledging our mutual desire to see and savor the beauty of Jesus in these days. Casting Crowns has a fresh take on "Joy to the World" called "Make Room":

...The sleeping town, they did not know That lying in a manger low A Savior King who had no home Has come to heal our sorrows

... Is there room in your heart? Is there room in your heart? Is there room in your heart For God to write His story?

This is the question I most needed to be reminded of: How am I preparing room in my heart for Jesus?

HomeGOING

Just a week prior, on Dec 6th, I stood in that same sanctuary reading my mom's eulogy. The Lord had mercifully taken mom to her heavenly home on Dec. 1st. Shortly before she passed away, I read John 14 to her: "There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am" (vs 2-3). Even though Christ's arrival to earth as a baby was met with a search for a room, my mom's arrival to heaven was met by an eternal room prepared just for her.

After the funeral ended, our family shared a final moment around the casket. Spontaneously and unplanned, one family member after another took out a white tissue or a handkerchief and waved goodbye to a wife, mother, grandmother, and child of God. Tears of laughter and sadness rolled down our cheeks as we remembered mom and dad's tradition of standing on their own porch, waving white handkerchiefs to say goodbye to their children and grandchildren who were returning to their homes in different cities and countries. This time, however, we were the ones waving good-bye to mom as she returned to her true and everlasting home.



HomeCOMING

One of our favorite moments of living and serving in Bolivia is when our girls come back home and bring their friends. Last Christmas, Kayla brought two of her delightful roommates for a visit---women of joy and wisdom. In April, Mariah brought 8 friends from her church in Denver to serve together on a short-term mission trip. Alongside this incredibly talented bunch we worked with 2 church plants doing art outreach, various kinds of multimedia training, worship and prayer; here is a 1 minute video of their art outreach in a school. In September, Hannah visited Bolivia to attend a wedding and jump on board during an especially full ministry schedule of back-to-back conferences, retreats and training.
