Spain - AVA women's conference for cross-cultural missionaries

I (Cami) have always enjoyed doing women's ministry, but in the past few years, I have had the honor of serving cross-cultural missionaries together with an exceptional team at AVA conferences. In a few days I will be travelling to Spain, where we will get together with over 100 women serving in 50 countries. As in previous years, I have the privilege of inviting along two Romanian workers. Besides serving as a Christian psychotherapist, I will also be leading daily small group meetings for the duration of the conference. No one else can understand the heart and challenges of a missionary woman as another missionary woman! Therefore, they have such a great need for encouragement, fellowship and care, and we have seen the difference this event makes in their life and work to spread the Gospel across the world. Here are the translated testimonies from two Romanian missionary ladies who attended the event in previous years:

"This was a special experience for me, despite the long trip, and I thank the Lord for this amazing time. I have received the peace my soul needed so much. I loved meeting other missionaries and sharing our experiences, I was encouraged, and I left with my heart full of joy and more courage to proclaim the Gospel." (E., Romanian missionary in Cyprus)

"AVA – a place, a time, burdened women, His presence and... me.

Getting a place at this conference was a miracle. When I arrived, I wondered 'why am I here?'. Hearing the testimonies of the other women, I thought about how blessed and problem-free I was compared to them. I didn't understand why I was there until the second day, when I met with my counsellor. Then she opened my 'file'. I was horrified at how well I had been hiding, I had put myself aside pretending I was doing well, to the point where I even started to believe it! I had hidden behind the problems of those around me and behind daily chores and tasks so well that I couldn't find myself anymore. And the most painful part was that I couldn't find the One who mattered to me most – my Lord and Savior, Jesus.

His Word, praise and worship songs, fellowship, encouragement, time to meditate – precious time I needed so much, prayer, His love and presence, healing, freedom, joy! – this was my experience at AVA.

The last sentences I wrote in my journal after the last day of the conference read: 'I am free! I went to bed as light as a feather! I slept through until 5.30 a.m. I don't even know if my roommate snored. I didn't hear her. I think she slept well too:). Today, I must climb the mountain and be with the Lord:).'

While at AVA I realized how much I needed this time to find myself again, time to find Him again. I was strengthened by the presence and testimonies of the other women. I wrote down everything I learnt so I can find myself in case I get lost again. I shared these truths with my sisters in the community where we serve and with my friends, because they too needed to be encouraged." (A., Romanian missionary in Far East Asia).



There is no greater joy or fulfilment for us than to facilitate fresh, authentic, transforming encounters between our Lord and His children, such as these. We're constantly experiencing this joy, but during these events, the glory and presence of our Lord is almost palpable.
