Sophia and I had the joy of returning to YWAM's University of the Nations campus in Kona this fall to work with the Community Development Schools. My ministry opportunities and training programs would not be possible without the prayer support and financial giving of our ministry partners, like you! I am so grateful to God for the 15 years I have been on the missions field, and also for your partnership as we build the Kingdom together!

This fall I was invited to serve as a school leader for one of the 2 Community Development Schools (CDS) at YWAM Kona. We train missionaries who desire to go to the field long term and want to see lasting transformation both in individual's lives and communities. This quarter, there are over 400+ DTS level students and my CDS school offers a chance after their graduation to get biblical training in principles for bearing lasting fruit in the nations.

Some of the topics we are learning together are biblical worldview (based on Genesis 1), spiritual reconciliation and healing the land, partnering with the local church, biblical justice and barriers to development. I had the chance to teach on community assessment and participatory development.



Teaching is my passion - both kids and adults! Here I had the opportunity to share with the Discipleship Training School (DTS) students on campus about the heart of Biblical Community Development - what does it mean to move people toward's God's intentions for them, not working out our own plans and strategies, but seeking God's heart for the people and place that we feel called

to and creating opportunities for the local people to participate in hearing from God and seeing their own transformation.

- When Sophia graduated from 1st grade, her school gave her a flyer for a music studio and she told me... "I would like to learn to play violin mommy." I told her that was a beautiful dream and she should pray to God for that chance. Now that we are in Kona, she is getting FREE violin lessons from another missionary and someone donated a violin that is just her size! She had beautiful childlike faith to see her prayers answered!
